



# Stop, look, listen, think

Your child needs to understand why each step of the STOP LOOK LISTEN THINK procedure is important. Use these questions when you practise crossing the road with your child.

<p><b>STOP</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is this a good place to cross the road?</li> <li>• Can you see the traffic coming in all directions?</li> <li>• Can the drivers see you?</li> <li>• Why have we stopped back from the road?</li> <li>• Why do you need to stop before crossing?</li> </ul>	
<p><b>LOOK</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What are we looking for?</li> <li>• Is any traffic coming?</li> <li>• Can you see the traffic if you only look straight ahead?</li> <li>• Why do you need to look in all directions?</li> <li>• Where else could traffic come from?</li> </ul>	
<p><b>LISTEN</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What do you need to listen for?</li> <li>• Can you hear any traffic coming?</li> <li>• Which direction is the sound coming from?</li> </ul>	
<p><b>THINK</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is it safe to cross now?</li> <li>• Is the road clear in all directions?</li> <li>• Can you hear any other traffic coming?</li> <li>• Can you get all the way across safely?</li> <li>• Is there somewhere to wait if you have to stop halfway?</li> </ul>
