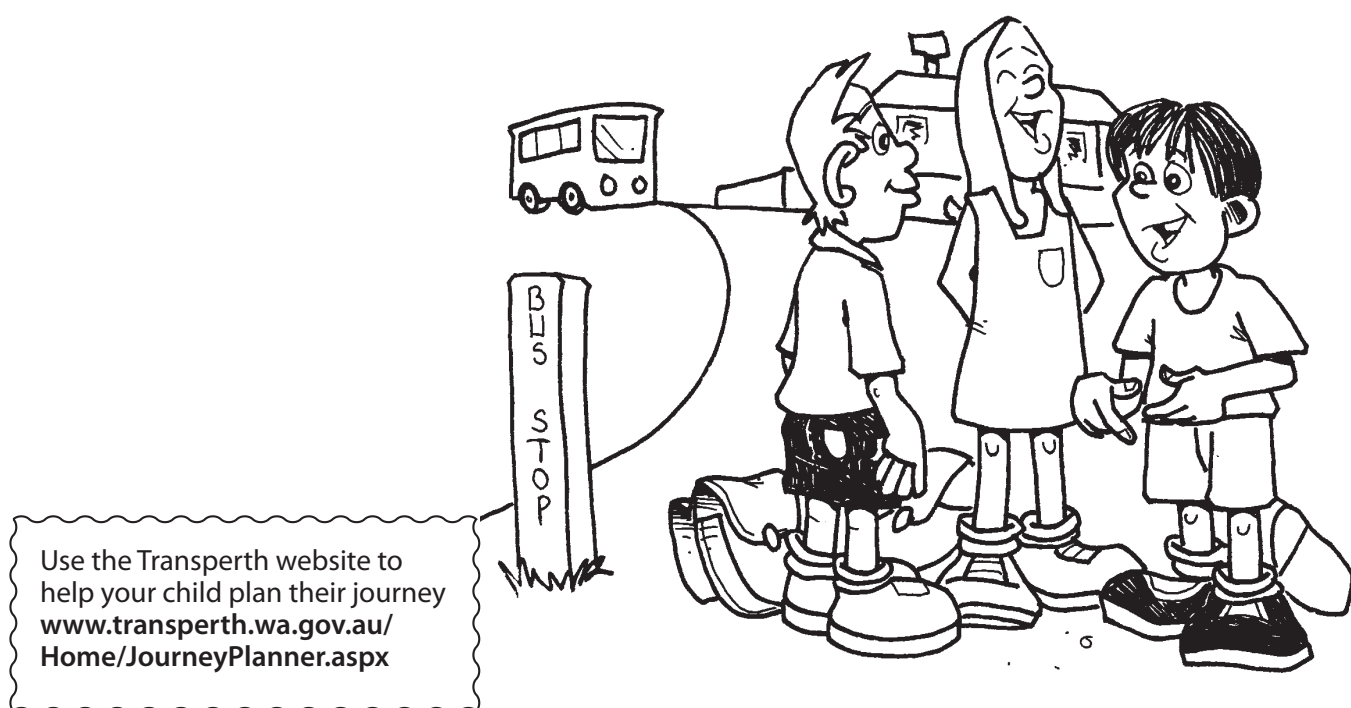




# Planning your bus travel
