<p>IMPLEMENTATION</p> <p>PK4L is the enrolment code for the 10-lesson <i>Keys for Life</i> program.</p> <p>SDERA's <i>Keys for Life</i> teacher and student resources are required for program delivery.</p> <p>Course completion must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendance at least 80% of <i>Keys for Life</i> lessons • Submission of a completed <i>Behind the Wheel</i> student journal to the teacher • Undertaking (but not necessarily passing) the Learner Theory Test. <p>Students completing the course receive an A (for achievement) on their Statement of Results.</p> <p>PK4L does not contribute any unit equivalence towards the WA Certificate of Education (WACE).</p>	<p>IMPLEMENTATION</p> <p>PK4L+ is the enrolment code for the 40-lesson <i>Keys for Life</i> program.</p> <p>SDERA's <i>Keys for Life</i> teacher and student resources are required for program delivery. Additional activities are available from www.sdera.wa.edu.au</p> <p>Course completion must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendance at least 80% of <i>Keys for Life</i> lessons • Submission of a completed <i>Behind the Wheel</i> student journal to the teacher • Undertaking (but not necessarily passing) the Learner Theory Test. <p>Students completing the course receive an A (for achievement) on their Statement of Results <u>and</u> one unit equivalent (five points) towards their WA Certificate of Education (WACE).</p>
<p>ENROLMENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A member of the school leadership team will complete the enrolment process at (using either use Excel, SIS or MAZE) http://www.scsa.wa.edu.au/internet/SIRS_Info/Enrolments • The enrolment deadline for Year 10, 11 and 12 students is August. Late enrolments can be discussed with SCSA (refer contact details below). 	
<p>RESULTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The results deadline for Year 10 and 11 students is the first week of December, and the first week of November for Year 12 students. Contact SCSA to confirm dates. • Students enrolled in PK4L or PK4L+ will receive an A, an N or a W. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A (Achieved) An 'A' result means that a student will have completed all program requirements, but not necessarily pass the test. N (Not Achieved) An 'N' result means that a student will not have met the program requirements (eg didn't complete and hand in their journal, didn't participate in at least 80% of the lessons, didn't sit the test). W (Withdrawn) A 'W' result means that a student will not have completed the program (eg left school, pulled out of the program half way through).
