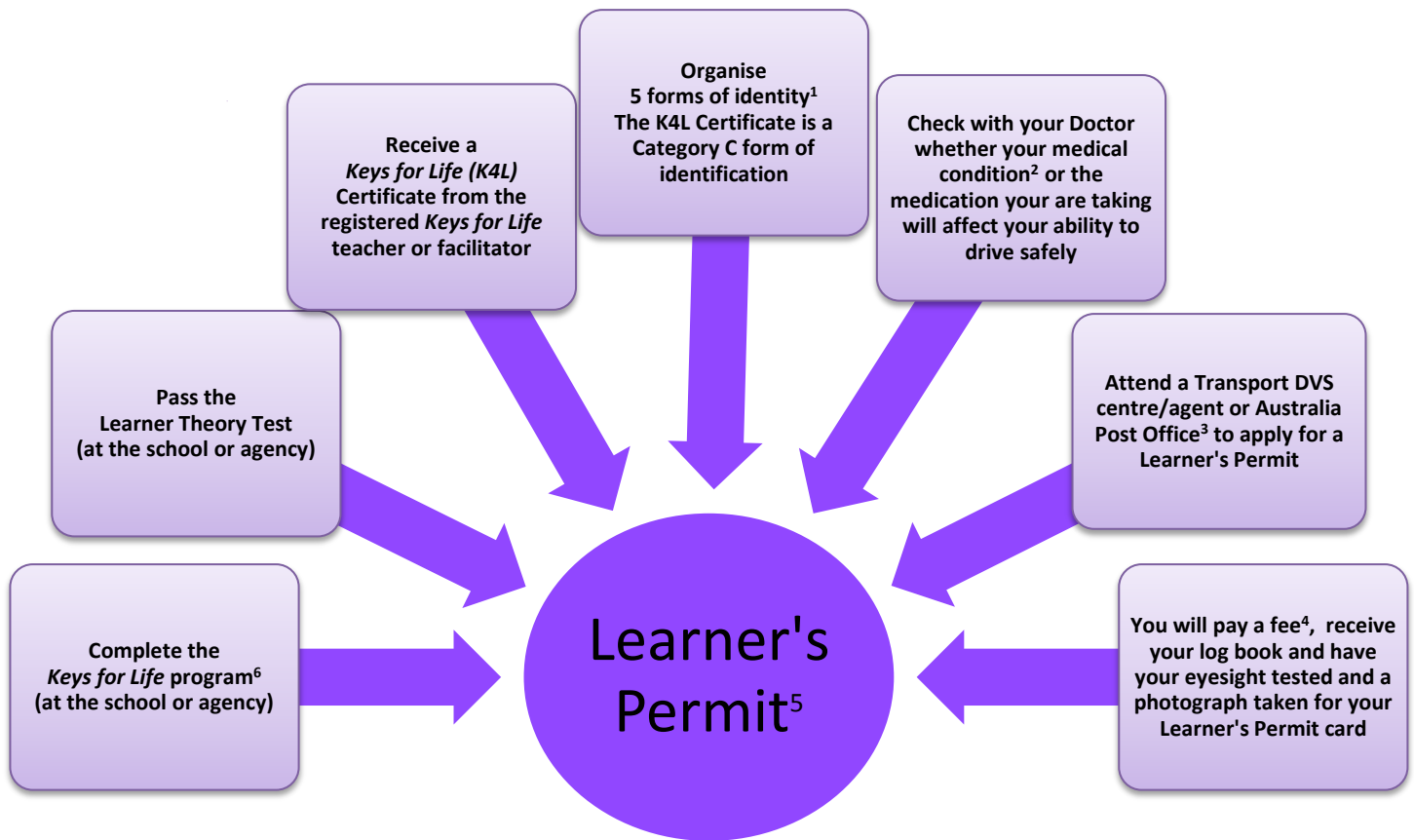


## How to use a *Keys for Life* Certificate when applying for a Learner's Permit in Western Australia



### 1 Proof of identification

When applying for a Learner's Permit you must bring five acceptable forms of identification. A *Keys for Life* Certificate is recognised as a Category C form of identification. ### 2 Medical declaration

You must declare on the Learner's Permit application form whether you have any medical conditions and/or take any medication. You will be advised if you need to have a medical assessment before you are granted your learner's permit. ### 3 Locations

Transport Driver and Vehicle Service centres and agents as well as participating Australia Post Offices will process Learner's Permits between the hours of 8.30am and 3.45pm, Monday to Friday. ### 4 Fees
