Discussion questions

Tell me what you can see in these pictures.

- Why are the children holding a grown up's hand?
- Whose hand do you hold when you go walking?

I wonder where else you need to hold a grown up's hand to stay safe. (In a car park, crossing a road, crossing at the traffic lights or crosswalk.)

Tell me what you can do if a grown up can't hold your hand. (Hold onto their clothes or arm, pram, shopping trolley or bag.)

Key messages for children

- Always hold a grown up's hand when you are walking near traffic.
- Hold onto the pram, shopping trolley or a grown up's clothing if you can't hold their hand.
- Keep checking for traffic when you are walking in a car park.

Key points

• Children should always be supervised by an adult while walking near and in traffic.
