Key messages for children

- Stop, look, listen, think before you cross the road with a grown up.
- Always hold a grown up's hand to cross the road.

Key points

- Children can be taught to cross the road with the help of an adult.
- Children need to practice crossing roads in a range of traffic situations.

Discussion questions

Tell me what you can see in these pictures.

What are the children looking for?

How are the grown ups helping the children?

Who helps you cross the road?

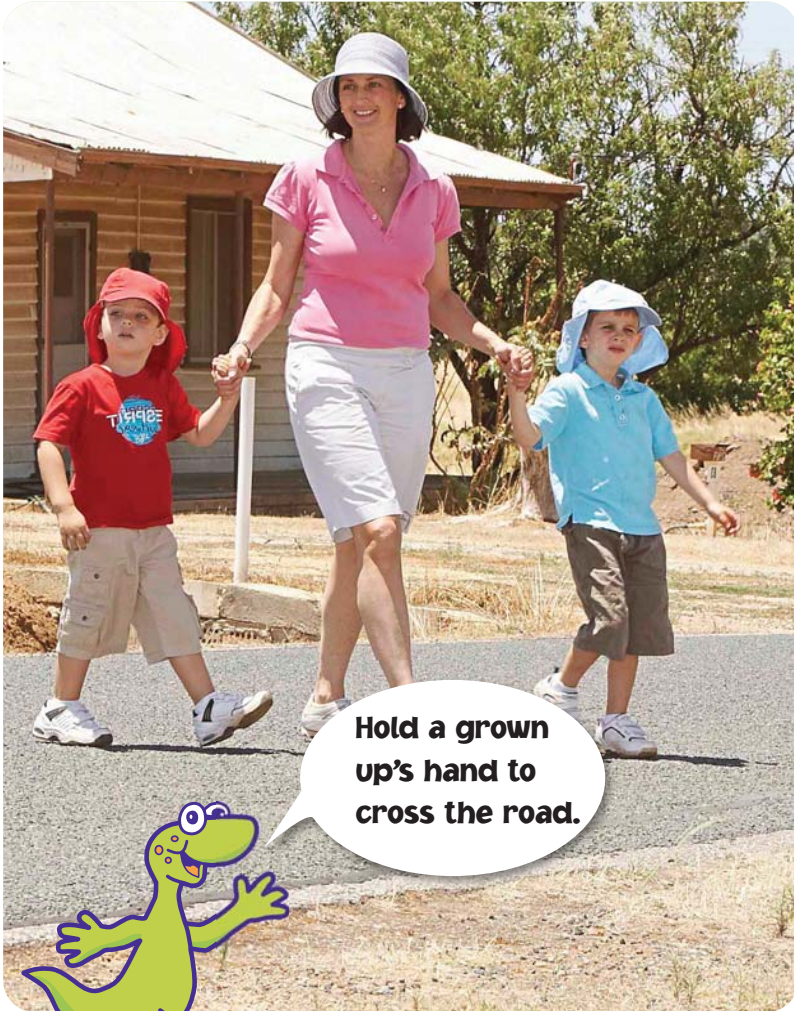
Tell me why you need to hold a grown up's hand when you cross the road. *(Make sure children understand that the grown up should be someone they know.)*

I wonder why the children and grown ups are standing back from the road.

What do you have to do when a grown up calls out 'stop'?

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Hold a grown up's hand to cross the road.
