

# Directions

Since 2011, the WA Road Safety Education Committee (WARSEC) have collaborated biennially to create an action plan titled *Directions: A Road Safety Education Plan for Western Australian Schools and Communities* with School Drug Education and Road Aware (SDERA) leading the process and publishing the document on behalf of WARSEC.

The three priority areas in *Directions 2015-2017* provide a framework for describing the range of programs and services that are freely available for early childhood, school and community settings in WA.

This report summarises the achievement of the actions described in each priority area.

### Priority 3


Strengthen leadership and collaboration of road safety education in WA

# Results


Of the 92 actions reported on by the WARSEC agencies for the period of 2015-2017, 97% were achieved.

## Priority 1


**Build a positive road safety culture in schools and early childhood services**




21 of the 22 actions were achieved in terms of supporting schools and early childhood services to build a positive road safety culture.




All 6 actions were achieved in terms of providing professional development for early childhood services and schools.



All 6 actions were achieved in terms of updating resources to reflect current research.




All 4 actions were achieved in terms of developing best practice resources.




All 13 actions were achieved in terms of promoting a positive road safety culture.

## Priority 2

**Promote road safety behaviours among young road users**




All 19 actions were achieved in terms of student-centred actions to assist young road users adopt safer behaviours.




All 8 actions were achieved in terms of supporting young road users to adopt safer behaviours.

## Priority 3

**Strengthen leadership and collaboration of road safety in WA**



10 out of 12 actions were achieved in terms of communicating and promoting road safety education knowledge.
