How to deliver a 40-lesson Keys4Life Plus (SCSA-endorsed) program

Choose some of the suggested activities listed below to deliver a 40 lesson 'Keys4Life Plus' course, over a semester. This is similar to a semester-long health education program with an emphasis on road safety, alcohol and other drugs and life skills.

Enrol students in Keys4Life Plus by **August** (at SCSA) in order for them to gain a **unit equivalence** (ie 5 points) towards their WACE. The criteria includes attending 80% of the lessons, completing a Behind the Wheel journal (or similar portfolio of activities) and attempting (but not necessarily passing) the Learner's Permit Test at school. Keys4Life Plus must be completed in one calendar year (not across 2 years).

SUGGESTED ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES
Real world activities such as changing a tyre, car maintenance drills, and a walking car rally in the local area.
Additional lessons to thoroughly learn the road rules in preparation for the Learner's Permit Theory Test.
Student journal completed during Keys4Life lessons with time to discuss the tasks in greater depth.
Compulsory Keys4Life Parent workshop for students and their parent/carer/family member.
Complete every activity in the Keys4Life Teacher resource and adapt to suit student needs.
Additional lesson about the learner's permit application process , (with or without a Keys4Life certificate) to explain in detail: forms of identity, medical declaration, how to use a Keys4Life certificate and the Log Book.
