

## SCSA-endorsed Keys4Life course

### Keys4Life course requirements and SCSA enrolment details

#### **Background**

Schools that implement the Keys4Life pre-driver education program (Keys4Life) are responsible for enrolling their students at the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (SCSA) for either one of the SCSA-endorsed Keys4Life courses – the standard 10-lesson course or the 40-lesson course. Both courses are endorsed and based on the same Keys4Life guidelines, materials, professional learning and test process. Students can be in Year 10, 11 or 12 when they participate and are enrolled in an endorsed course. After completing the course and being enrolled by the school, students will gain 'Achievement' and/or 'Unit Equivalence' towards their WA Certificate of Education (WACE) and WA Statement of Secondary Achievement (WASSA). 'Unit Equivalence' is only relevant to the 40-lesson course and suggestions for implementing the 40-lesson course are on page 2 of this handout.

# Suggestions for implementing the 40-lesson SCSA-endorsed Keys4Life course

Complete all 23 activities in the Keys4Life Teacher Resource and adapt to suit student needs.

Deliver extra lessons about the road rules in preparation for the Learner's Permit Test.

Deliver real world activities eg changing a tyre, car maintenance, observing local traffic.

Review the Learner's Permit process including identity check, medical declaration and Log Book.

Complete the Keys4Life Student Workbook and the Behind the Wheel Student Journal.

Review all tasks and quizzes in the Behind the Wheel journal and the Keys4Life workbook.

Organise a Keys4Life Parent information session for students and their parent/carer member.
